



Why We Hold to the King James Bible

The King James Bible has the right Greek text





1 Timothy 3:16

All of the modern versions remove the word GOD in this verse, because the modern Greek text removes it


"And without controversy great is the mystery of godliness: God was manifest in the flesh, justified in the Spirit, seen of angels, preached unto the Gentiles, believed on in the world, received up into glory." (1 Tim. 3:16)

The King James Bible Has the Right Greek N.T.

The KJV Greek text was the one that was preserved among God's people through the centuries

Four Periods of Church History

- 1. Apostolic: giving of the Bible
- 2. 2^{nd-3rd} centuries: corruption of the Bible
- 3. Dark Ages: persecution of the Bible
- 4. Reformation: printing of the Bible



The New Testament Was Written

"Howbeit when he, the Spirit of truth, is come, he will guide you into all truth: for he shall not speak of himself; but whatsoever he shall hear, that shall he speak: and he will show you things to come." *John 16:13*

The New Testament Was Completed

"Beloved, when I gave all diligence to write unto you of the common salvation, it was needful for me to write unto you, and exhort you that ye should earnestly contend for the faith which was once delivered unto the saints." Jude 3

The New Testament Was Received

"For I have given unto them the words which thou gavest me; and they have received them, and have known surely that I came out from thee, and they have believed that thou didst send me." *John 17:8*

The New Testament Was Received

"For this cause also thank we God without ceasing, because, when ye received the word of God which ye heard of us, ye received it not as the word of men, but as it is in truth, the word of God, which effectually worketh also in you that believe." *1 Thess. 2:13*

All of this must be accepted by FAITH!

"But without faith it is impossible to please him..." Hebrews 11:6

"Now faith is the substance of things hoped for, the evidence of things not seen." *Hebrews 11:1*

The New Testament Was Attacked

PETER'S TESTIMONY: "...in which are some things hard to be understood, WHICH THEY THAT ARE UNLEARNED AND UNSTABLE WREST, AS THEY DO ALSO THE OTHER SCRIPTURES..." 2 Pet. 3:16

Four Periods of Church History

2. 2nd & 3rd centuries: *corruption of the Bible*

"In the age in which the [Latin] Vulgate was formed, the church was infested with Origenists and Arians; an affinity between any manuscript and that version consequently conveyed some suspicion that its text was corrupted." --Frederick Nolan

"...the worst corruptions to which the New Testament has ever been subjected, originated within a hundred years after it was composed."

—Frederick Scrivener (1813-1891)


The Scriptures were mutilated and shortened

"Marcion and his followers have betaken themselves to mutilating the Scriptures. ... They assert that these alone are authentic which they themselves have shortened." —Irenaeus (150 A.D.)

The Scriptures were added to

Many spurious writings appeared:

- The Gospel of Thomas
- The Gospel of Nicodemus
- The Gospel of Barnabas



The School in Alexandria


CLEMENT led the school from 190 to 202 A.D.

- He intermingled Christianity with pagan philosophy
- He was one of the fathers of purgatory
- He taught that most men would eventually be saved

ORIGEN 185-254 A.D.


This Egyptian laid the foundation for the modern versions by introducing textual changes

- He denied the perfect inspiration of Scripture
- He taught baptismal regeneration
- He believed in purgatory
- He believed the Holy Spirit was a created being
- He believed that even Satan would be saved




Origen 185-254 A.D.

- He believed that men's souls are preexistent
- He believed the stars and planets have souls
- He believed Jesus was created and is not eternally God
- He spiritualized the Bible saying, "The Scriptures have little use to those who understand them literally."




EUSEBIUS 270-340 A.D.

• He collected the writings of Origen and promoted his false teachings



Eusebius 270-340 A.D.

• He produced Greek Bibles for Constantine, the father of church statism

• Vaticanus and Sinaiticus are thought to be two of these

"It is quite possible that Aleph and B are two of these fifty." A.T. Robertson

The modern Greek text is called "The Alexandrian Text"

The Greek manuscripts that support the modern versions are called "Alexandrian," because they came from Alexandria, Egypt

JEROME 340-420 A.D.

He used the Eusebius-Origen text to create the Catholic Latin Vulgate


- He promoted veneration of bones and holy relics
- He promoted prayers to the dead
- He taught that Mary is a perpetual virgin
- He promoted infant baptism
- He justified the death penalty for "heretics"


















During the Middle Ages the Alexandrian text was used by Rome but rejected by others


- We have more than five thousand Greek manuscripts from this period, and the vast majority are the Received Text
- The Waldenses used the Received Text



















God's People Believed They Had the Preserved Scriptures


"The Old Testament in Hebrew . . . and the New Testament in Greek . . . being immediately inspired by God, and by his singular care and providence kept pure in all ages, are therefore authentical; so as in all controversies of religion, the Church is finally to appeal unto them." Westminster Confession, 1648

Protestant Confession of Faith, London, 1679

"And by the holy scriptures we understand, the canonical books of the old and new testament, as they are now translated into our English mother-tongue, of which there hath never been any doubt of their verity and authority, in the protestant churches of Christ to this day."

Even modern textual criticsadmit this

"It is undisputed that from the 16th to the 18th century orthodoxy's doctrine of verbal inspiration assumed ... [the] Received Text ... they regarded it as the 'original text.' ... it was regarded as preserving even to the last detail the inspired and infallible word of God Himself." Kurt Aland, 1987



"Call this text Erasmian or Complutensian, the text of Stephens, or of Beza, or of the Elzevirs, call it the Received or the Traditional, or by whatever name you please—the fact remains that a text has come down to us which is attested by a general consensus of ancient Copies, ancient Fathers, and ancient Versions."
